## 2017--TOWN OF SHERWOOD, CLARK COUNTY, WI. FEBRUARY TOWN BOARD MEETING

February 14, 2017

The Town of Sherwood met Tuesday, February 14, 2017 at the Sherwood Town Hall. Supervisor I, Kenneth Schwanebeck, Supervisor II, Curtis Anding, Clerk, Alene Jacobson and Treasurer Margaret -Peggi- Schwanebeck was also present. Chairman Andrew Cegielski was not present because he is out of state on his honeymoon. No town electors were present.

This meeting notice was published in the Pittsville Record and posted at the town hall, at the substation on County Road W and at Roadhouse Bar & Grill. The agenda as follows: call to order, approval of minutes by town board, treasurer's report, town correspondence, reports from town officers & committees, public comments upon recognition of the chairman, matters for discussion & possible action by the town board in open session—road updates, taxes, dogs & TRIP grant received/sent, pay bills, and set town board meeting for March 2017 and adjournment.

Supervisor Ken Schwanebeck called this meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes of the previous meeting were read. A motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Curtis Anding to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Peggi Schwanebeck gave the treasurer's report. The tax collection season is officially over as of February 6, 2017.

<u>ROADS</u>: Ken Schwanebeck called the Clark County Highway Dept. to sand our roads right after the last ice storm as the township roads were very slippery and the school bus needed help.

TRIP GRANT RECEIVED: A motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Curtis Anding to ask the Board of Commissioner of Public Lands to approve a loan payment of \$80,000 in 2017. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Clerk will write to them asking for their approval of this payment. The TRIP program paid us \$76,767.55 for this project and we would like to round it off to \$80,000. Our first loan payment is due March 2018.

<u>PAY BILLS:</u> Board approved checks #3549 through #3571. Our next town board meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 14, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at the Sherwood Town Hall. A motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Curtis Anding to adjourn. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Meeting adjourned. (6:50 p.m.)
