2018--TOWN OF SHERWOOD, CLARK COUNTY, WI. FEBRUARY TOWN BOARD MEETING

February 13, 2018

The Town Board of Sherwood met Tuesday, February 13, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the Sherwood Town Hall. Supervisor I, Kenneth Schwanebeck, Supervisor II, Curtis Anding, Clerk, Alene Jacobson, & Treasurer Margaret Schwanebeck were present. Chairman Andrew Cegielski was absent because he was on vacation out of State. One township resident was present - Travis Kumm. This notice was published in the Pittsville Record, and posted in three places in the township--at the town hall, Connie's Roadhouse Bar & Grill and at the substation on County Road W. The agenda as follows--call to order, approval of minutes by town board, treasurer's report, town correspondence, reports from town officers, public comments, specific matters for discussion and possible action by town board in open session--roads updates, 50-50 road grant approval, taxes-any updates, pay bills, set town board meeting for March 2018 and adjournment.

Supervisor Ken Schwanebeck called this meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes of the previous meeting were read. One notation added--Kenneth Schwanebeck cannot go to the Board of Review training session scheduled for Saturday, February 24 because he will be on vacation out of State. After this addition, a motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Curtis Anding to accept the minutes. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Treasurer Peggi Schwanebeck gave the treasurer's report. Tax season for our treasurer is officially over. The balance on hand as of January 31, 2018 is \$132,193.46. The County has not finished the tax rolls because of a malfunction in their software and they are working to solve this issue.

<u>PUBLIC COMMENTS:</u> Pulping & logging is not finished yet. They will be removing logs from Todd Road, Poertner Road, Blueberry Road and The Sherwood Lake County park yet before spring breakup.

50-50 ROAD GRANT APPROVAL: Supervisor Ken Schwanebeck applied for the 50-50 road grant. The application, projected cost of materials, maps, and any other information that the County needed for this application drawn up by Ken Schwanebeck. The roads applied for is Ballard Road west of Division Avenue to Washburn Township and all of Division Avenue. After discussing all information a motion by Curtis Anding, seconded by Ken Schwanebeck to apply for this grant. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. The present town board signed this application and it will be sent to the Clark County Forestry & Parks Department before the deadline.

<u>PAY BILLS</u>: Board approved checks #3743 through #3760. Our next town board meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 13, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the Sherwood Town Hall. A motion by Kenneth Schwanebeck, seconded by Curtis Anding to adjourn. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Meeting adjourned. (6:40 pm.)
