

# 2018--TOWN OF SHERWOOD, CLARK COUNTY, WI. MARCH TOWN BOARD MEETING

March 13, 2018

The Town Board of Sherwood met Tuesday, March 13, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the Sherwood Town Hall. All town board members present including clerk & treasurer. There was 2 electors also present-- Travis Kumm & Cyril Rakovec. This notice was published in the Pittsville Record and posted in three places in the township--at the town hall, Connie's Roadhouse Bar & Grill and at the substation on County Road W. The agenda as follows--call to order, approval of minutes by town board, treasurer's report, town correspondence, reports from town officers, public comments upon recognition of the chairman, specific matters for discussion & possible action by Town Board in open session--roads, any updates, 50-50 road grant program, tax payments to Peggi, cemetery fence, stumps & logs, set dates for Open Book & Board of Review, pay bills, set town board meeting for April 2018 and adjournment.

Chairman Andy Cegielski called this meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes of the previous were read. **MEETINGS:** None Noted.


**50-50 ROAD GRANT PROGRAM:** No more information available at this time.
