

**2019--TOWN OF SHERWOOD, CLARK COUNTY, WI.**  
**FEBRUARY TOWN BOARD MEETING**  
**February 11, 2019**

The Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Monday, February 11, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at the Sherwood Town Hall. Supervisor I, Ken Schwanebeck, Supervisor II, Curtis Anding & Clerk, Alene Jacobson were present. Treasurer, Peggi Schwanebeck was absent because she was on call at work. There were no town electors present.

This notice was published in the Pittsville Record. The agenda was posted within the township at the Town Hall. The agenda as follows: call to order, approval of minutes by the town board, town correspondence, reports from town officers, public comments, specific matters for discussion and possible action in open session--roads-updates, taxes-updates and loan payment, pay bills, set town board meeting for March 2019 and adjournment.

Supervisor Ken Schwanebeck called this meeting to order at 6:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes of the previous meeting were read. A motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Curtis Anding to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Acting chairman, Ken Schwanebeck read the treasurer's report. We have approximately \$159,136.15 in checking at this time.


This meeting was conducted to mainly pay bills due in February and keep up with the mail that may need to be acted on in the near future. The February payments for Schools and County taxes were written out and Treasurer Peggi Schwanebeck will stop at the Clerk's home to sign the checks within a couple days (weather permitting) so all bills will be paid on time.

**CORRESPONDENCE:** Clerk received an *incident report from the Granton Area Fire Dept.* regarding a car fire at the address of W3073 Sherwood Road. Clerk did not recognize the name of Linda Garrett with this address and called the Clerk of Washburn Township and she said it was theirs, so the report was mailed to the Town of Washburn.

*Received statement from Cooper Propane.* They delivered 250 gallons of propane last month and Supervisor Ken said it was just an activity report and not a bill at this time. *We received a letter from the WTA* regarding a membership invoice for us to join the Towns Advocacy Council in 2019. No action taken today. This letter will be sent to Chairman Andy for his opinion and if he wants us to join at a cost of \$.25 per resident in 2019 we will act on it after he comes home. This payment will be due in July 2019. *A new fire number was applied for.* Information was sent to us from the Clark County Courthouse for N644 Colonial Avenue. David Peters, Vesper, WI applied for a new address and notified the County of a small hunting cabin that will be constructed soon.

**PAY BILLS:** Board approved checks #3935 through #3949. Our next town board meeting will be Monday, March 11, 2019 at 6:00 pm at the Sherwood Town Hall. A motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Curtis Anding to adjourn. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Meeting adjourned. (6:30 pm)
