

**2020--TOWN OF SHERWOOD, CLARK COUNTY, WI.
FEBRUARY TOWN BOARD MEETING**

February 12, 2020

The Town Board of Sherwood met Wednesday, February 12, 2020 at 6:00 pm at the Sherwood Town Hall. Supervisor I, Ken Schwanebeck, Supervisor II, Curtis Anding, Clerk, Alene Jacobson and Treasurer Peggi Schwanebeck were present. Chairman Andy Cegielski was absent because he is still on vacation in Florida. Grader operator Travis Kumm was also present. There were no other electors present. This notice was published in the Pittsville Record and posted within the township. The agenda as follows: call to order, approval of last month's minutes by town board, treasurer's report, town correspondence, reports from town officers, public comments upon recognition of the town board, specific matters for discussion and possible action in open session: Board of Review certification meeting in Marshfield, road updates & taxes updates; pay bill, set town board meeting for March 2020 and adjournment.


Supervisor, Ken Schwanebeck called this meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes of the previous meeting were read. A motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Curtis Anding to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Peggi Schwanebeck gave the treasurer's report. We have \$152,451.41 on hand as of January 31, 2020. The dollar amount also includes property taxes that need to be paid this month.

PUBLIC COMMENTS & CORRESPONDENCE: H&S Manufacturing sold their properties at the end of Todd Road ~~to Lake Dubuque~~ for over \$700,000. They owned over 480 acres alone in Clark County and some land in Wood County. Parcels of woods on Todd Road, Cherry Road, Poertner Road and Sandhill Avenue are being logged off this winter. It has come to my attention that the new 2019 John Deere Grader & snowplow was not put on our township insurance yet. Clerk will look into this and notify Rural Insurance regarding this new JD Grader. Can we charge a fee for anyone requesting special assessment information including finance companies regarding parcels of land up for sale? Sometimes this request takes time to complete. No action taken at this time.

TAX COLLECTIONS: All property taxes 1st installment was due by February 6, 2020. There are some checks still up in the air, but now the Courthouse has to deal with this.

PAY BILLS: Board approved checks #4140 through #4163. Our next town board meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 11, 2020 at 6:00 pm at the Sherwood Town Hall. A motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Curtis Anding to adjourn. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Meeting adjourned (6:45 pm)
