FEBRUARY 12, 2022


The Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Saturday, February 12, 2022 at 9:30 am the Sherwood Town hall. Supervisor Ken Schwanebeck Supervisor Rick Schwanebeck, Clerk Alene Jacobson and Treasurer Peggi Schwanebeck were present. Chairman Andy Cegielski was absent because he was out of town. There were no town residents present.

This notice was published in the Pittsville Record and posted at the town hall. Agenda as follows: call to order, Pledge of Allegiance was recited, approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report, town correspondence, report's from town officers, public comments, specific matters for discussion and possible action by the town board--road updates, garbage & recycling updates, grader loan payment, county/town road grant app, beaver updates, taxes updates, pay bills, set town board meeting for March 2022 and adjournment.

Supervisor Ken Schwanebeck called this meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes of the previous meeting were read. A motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Rick Schwanebeck to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Peggi Schwanebeck gave the treasurer's report. We have \$196904.16 in our checking account at this time.

We have the opportunity to apply for a 50 / 50 grant for road improvements this year. Therefore a motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Rick Schwanebeck to apply for the 50/50 grant. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Clerk will do the paperwork and send it to the Clark County Courthouse. The town of Washburn is processing a Beaver contract with Lynn Moeller too. He will charge \$100.00 per year and \$30.00 per beaver removed in 2022. Pay Bills: Board approved Checks #4534 through #4556. Our next town board meeting will be held on Saturday, March 12, 2022 at 9:30 am at the Sherwood Town Hall. Therefore a motion by Ken Schwanebeck, seconded by Rick Schwanebeck to adjourn. Motion carried by 2/3 majority. Meeting adjourned.
