JUNE TOWN BOARD MINUTES

June 13th, 2023

The Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Saturday, June 13, 2023 at 6:30 PM at the Sherwood Town Hall. Chairman, Andy Cegielski, Supervisor, Ken Schwanebeck, Supervisor, Rick Schwanebeck, Clerk, Margaret "Peggi" Schwanebeck and Treasurer Jessica Bucheger were present. Also present was town resident: Albert Bucheger, Marla Martin, Lynn Moeller and Paul Bugar.

The notice was posted at the Sherwood Town Hall and at the Sherwood Electrical Substation.

Agenda as follows: call to order, pledge of allegiance, reading and approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report and town correspondence, Reports-town officers' public comment (upon recognition by the chairman), open gravel bids, Mg/Cl for town roads, follow-up on snow plowing by the Town of Lynn, Beaver Contract, follow up on trees on Sherwood Rd, Anderson Rd, and Division Rd, Follow up on purchasing fuel locally, Follow up on needed roads signs and costs, brush cutting, change of Picnic Date and location, time frames for Assessors visits and JJ Brush cutting of roadsides, and internet cost to hall and storage cabinets for hall.

Chairman Andy Cegielski called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. The pledge of allegiance was recited. The Gravel Bid was opened. Paul Bugar Trucking, Inc. had the only bid. Gravel is \$13.90 per yard delivered. Delivery date for sometime in August. Ken S. made a motion to accept the bid, it was seconded by Rick S.. Motion carried.

Minutes from the May 2023 meeting were read. Correction to 80000 pounds. Ken S. made a motion to accept the minutes with the necessary correction, seconded by Rick S.. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report was given. We have \$65001.46 in the bank.
4895 gallons Mg/Cl was spread on town roads. Ballard to the west will be added to next years spreading.

We received paperwork for a fire number for the new Cell Tower to be built on Badger north. Veterans Day-Thank you to Marla Martin for making the necessary arrangements.
Annual Picnic Date has been changed to August 26th, 2023, and will be held at Neals Pond formerly Coulthard's Pond. Motion by Andy C. for the new date and location, seconded by Ken S.. Motion carried.

Beaver Contract was sign by Lynn Moeller and the Town of Sherwood. He will remove beavers that are causing issues to our roads (flooding,etc).

Ditch on Division is draining. Andy has not spoke to Trevor yet about the Sherwood Rd ditch cleaning. Andy asked if we received a bill from Dirt Brothers for Division. Not yet.

The Dan Ostrowski will take care of the trees on Anderson Rd..
Road signs: Ken S. has a list of Road name signs. 6 inch/\$27.50, 9inch/ \$41.00. \$39.00 for Stop and roads. 48-49 needed. Approximately \$1347 for 6 inches and \$2033 for 9 inches from Rent a Flash. Ken S. will do a review of all signs.

Courmoyer Oil will be contacted for fuel when it is needed. Rick made a motion to call Courmoyer Oil for fuel, seconded by Ken S.. Motion approved.

Have not seen the Assessor yet.

Tyler Jacobson from J&J Brush Cutting will be mowing one pass in the end of June or early

July. He will give us a quote for brushing on Sherwood, Anderson Ballard and Poertner roads. Verizon will let us know what they will be doing about a culvert on Badger prior to starting any work.

Waste Management: Cans must be 3 feet apart.
Town of Lynn: We will be plowing Badger Rd North. Rick S. made a motion to call Opelt Sand & Gravel to sand Badger Rd north, seconded by Ken S.. Motion carried.
Stray dogs if vicious, the Sheriff's Dept. will be called. Rick S. has a large dog kennel if the Clark City Humane Society is closed.
Internet at Sherwood Town Hall: Rick made a motion to install internet service to the Hall, seconded by Ken S.. Motion carried.
Temporary Bar and Operators licenses for the Bullhead Bash put on by the Southern Wisconsin Sportsman Club were paid for and picked up by Lynn Moeller.
The board approved checks #4813 to 4826.
The next meeting will be Tuesday, July 11th, 2023, at 6:30 PM.
A motion by Ken S. and seconded by Rick S to adjourn. Motion carried.
