

# 2023-TOWN OF SHERWOOD, CLARK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

## MAY TOWN BOARD MINUTES

May 13th, 2023

The Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Saturday, May 13, 2023 at 9:30AM at the Sherwood Town Hall. Chairman, Andy Cegielski, Supervisor I, Ken Schwanebeck, Supervisor II, Rick Schwanebeck, Clerk, Margaret "Peggi" Schwanebeck and Treasurer Jessica Bucheger were present. Also present was town resident: Bill Rosandick, Albert Bucheger, Liam Bucheger, Hallie Bucheger, Bob Fluegel. The notice was published in the Pittsville Record, posted at the town hall and at the Sherwood Electrical Substation.

Agenda as follows: call to order, pledge of allegiance, reading and approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report and town correspondence, town officer's report, public comments, meet with Rural Insurance rep, discuss gravel bidding, snowplowing by the Town of Lynn, installing an office in the hall, discussing internet service to the town hall, computer purchase for the clerk and treasurer, replacing of missing or damaged road signs, calcium chloride for dust control, ditching and mowing of ditches, renewal of beaver removal contract, discuss Living Local App platform, picnic date and preparations for Memorial Day celebrations for the veterans, new business, followed by the paying of bills, set Town Board meeting for June and adjournment. Chairman Andy Cegielski called the meeting to order at 09:30AM. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Ian Pierce was asked to present our Rural Insurance Policy.

Ian Pierce from Rural Insurance recapped our policy for the Town. He explain the coverage for the Buildings, Personal property in town hall, Portable Equipment, Property Endorsements, Liability, and Cyber Liability coverages. He updated the drivers covered for the grade operation. They are: Ken Schwanebeck, Rick Schwanebeck, Travis Kumm, Bob Fluegel, and Al Bucheger. The Inflation Guard has increased by 9%, the John Deere 622G Grader was added to the policy with an increase in cost of \$814.00. The drivers list was updated, towing was added and the correction of the manufacturers name for the plow and V-wing. The Surety Bond had the clerk and treasurers names updated. The clerk will send a copy of the Annual Report. Ian explained what a subcontractor is. He will contact the clerk with the updates and any costs.

Bill Rosandick read the April 2023 Town meeting minutes. A motion by Ken Schwanebeck and seconded by Rick Schwanebeck to accept the minutes as read. Approved. Bill Rosandick was Thanked by the town board for the amazing work as the Interim Clerk for the Town of Sherwood. The Treasurer's report was given and accepted. We have \$53871.74.

Road Signs: We purchase road signs from Rent a Flash or Hilco. We have missing signs. Andy will check on pricing.

Laptops were purchased for the town clerk and the town treasurer from Best Buy for \$1394.96.

Ditch Mowing: We received a bid for Mowing of Roadside Grass & Brush from JJ's Brush Cutting Services, LLC. Loyal WI. \$70/hr for roadside mowing. \$80/hr for roadside brush cutting. This is an increase of \$5.00 from 2022. A motion to accept the bid by Andy and seconded by Rick. Approved.

Calcium Chloride: Andy spoke with John Meyer about the pricing. The pricing is \$1.35/gal. For a full load \$4500.

Ken made a motion to purchase 1 tanker load in June; seconded by Rick. Approved.

50/50 Road Grant: We did not win the grant this year.

Beaver Contract: Andy will ask Lynn Moeller if he wants to renew the contract to remove beavers that are causing roadway flooding. A motion made by Andy and seconded by Rick to renew Lynn Moeller contract if he is interested. Beavers need to be removed west of the Stanton's cabin on Dyer Rd and the Sherwood Rd. Andy notified Clark County about the beavers on Sherwood Rd.

Christi Muggerrud-Schmitz a Communication Engagement Specialist asked if we would be interest in joining Living Local. This is a web service. We are not interested at this time.

Town of Lynn-snowplowing: We have paid out \$2950 since January 1, 2023. We need a contract for sanding and salting without plowing as we will grade the 1.5 miles on Badger Ave North. Wisc.DOT weight limit restrictions: The Town of Lynn would like us to join them in reducing the weight limit down to 8 tons. Class B roads a 40% of the 80,000 pounds (32000). Andy will speak with the Town of Lynn.

Internet service to the Town Hall: Peggi will check on the price. This is for an office to be put in the hall.

Rick attended the Granton First Responders meeting, and he brought the new contract for the Granton First Responders. This was signed.

Ken Schwanebeck ask to have Coumoyer for our Diesel purchased. This will be put on the agenda for the June meeting.

Gravel Bids will be sent to the local papers and posted in the town. Andy has the necessary forms for the bids. Bids will need to be received by June 13, 2023 06:30 PM.

Memorial Day Service will be held at Neil's Pond. Marla Moeller is handling the preparations.

Town of Sherwood Annual Picnic will be held on Sept. 2, 2023 at the Sherwood Park Pavilion. Recognition for Alene Jacobson 40 years of service as our Clerk.

Division Ave: The road will be checked after the Logger completes his job.

Assessor: Andy will contact Chimney Rock Appraisals about the re-assessing and the Board of Review scheduling.

ARPA: Andy spoke with Joy Eichton from Town of Granton to get help enter this years report.

Bills Paid: Board approved checks number 4802 to 4812. Our next board meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 13, 2023. A motion to adjourn was made by Ken Schwanebeck and seconded by Rick Schwanebeck. Approved
