

## **2024 TOWN OF SHERWOOD**

**September 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024**

The meeting of the Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Saturday, September 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024, at 9:00am at the Sherwood Town Hall, W896 Sherwood Rd, Pittsville, WI. Supervisor, Ken Schwanebeck, Supervisor, Rick Schwanebeck, Treasurer, Jessica Bucheger and Clerk, Margaret "Peggi" Schwanebeck were present. Resident: Albert Bucheger was present.

The notice was posted at the Sherwood Town Hall, the Roadhouse Bar & Grill and at the Sherwood Electrical Substation.

Agenda as follows: call to order, pledge of allegiance, reading and approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report and town correspondence, Reports from the town officers. Continuing Business, Public comment (upon recognition of chairman), Pay bills, set date for October 2024 Town Board meeting, and adjournment.

Supervisor Ken Schwanebeck called the meeting to order at 9:00am. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Minutes from the August 6th, 2024, meeting was read. Ken S. made a motion to accept the minutes as read and it was seconded by Rick S. The motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. We have \$50427.45 in the bank on August 31st, 2024.

#### **Presentation of Pittsville School Referendum**

Mary Ann Lippert, President of the Pittsville School Board, presented the reason for the necessary Referendum for use in the General Operational funds for the school. Residents will receive information in the mail or on the school's website about the costs of operations to be covered by the referendum. It is a request for 4 years of money from taxpayers. The State's calculation for funding each student is leaving a short fall of money for the operations of the school.
