The meeting of the Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Saturday January 18th,2025 at 1006am at the Sherwood Town Hall, W896 Sherwood Rd, Granton, WI. Supervisor Ken Schwanebeck, Supervisor, Rick Schwanebeck, Treasurer, Bill Rosandick and Clerk, Margaret "Peggi" Schwanebeck were present.
