SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF ELECTORS

BUDGET AND LEVY MEETINGS

The Budget Meeting of the Electors of the Town of Sherwood was called to order by Chairman Andy Cegielski on Tuesday November 12th, 2024, at 6:32 pm at the Sherwood Town Hall. Electors present: Lowell Freedlund, Albert Bucheger, William Rosandick, Ken Schwanebeck, Rick Schwanebeck, Jessica Bucheger, Margaret Schwanebeck, and Anndy Cegielski.

The notice of the Budget and Levy Special Meetings was published in the *Pittsville Record*, and posted at the Sherwood Town Hall, the Roadhouse Bar & Grill, and at the Electric Company substation on Hwy W.

The agenda is as follows: Budget Meeting, discussion and approval by Electors. Levy Meeting, discussion and approval.

2025 BUDGET Meeting: Andy Cegielski called the meeting to order at 06:32pm on November 12, 2024. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Lowell Freedlund asked why the amount for the Cemetery plots was not correct. The clerk had not received notification of lots purchased in the month of October. Revenues for 2025 totals for the Severance were decreased by \$7000 after receiving notification from the WI Department of Revenue. A motion by Ken Schwanebeck to accept the 2025 Budget as presented; and seconded by Rick Schwanebeck. The motion passed with a unanimous vote of 8-0.

A motion by Rick Schwanebeck was made to adjourn the meeting at 6:42pm; and seconded by Ken Schwanebeck. The motion carried.

2024 Levy Meeting: Andy Cegielski called the meeting to order at 6:43pm following the Budget Meeting of the Town Electors. The Clerk read the amount of the Levy for the WI DOR of \$26634. The loan payment for the JD grader will be added to the Levy in the amount of \$31887. The total Levy amount is \$58521. Andy Cegielski made a motion to accept the Levy as presented; and was seconded by Ken Schwanebeck. The motion passed with a unanimous vote of 8-0.

A motion by Ken Schwanebeck was made to adjourn the meeting at 6:45pm; and seconded by Rick Schwanebeck. The motion carried.
