

2025 TOWN OF SHERWOOD

CLARK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

October 14th, 2025

The meeting of the Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Tuesday October 14th, 2025 at 6:00pm at the Sherwood Town Hall, W896 Sherwood Rd, Granton, WI. Board members present: Andy Cegielski, Lowell Freedlund, Rick Schwanebeck, Margaret Schwanebeck, and Samantha Balsiger. Sheriff Kerry Kim.

The notice was posted at the Sherwood Town Hall, the Town of Sherwood website, Connie's Roadside Bar & Grill, and at the Sherwood Electrical Substation.

Agenda as follows: call to order, pledge of allegiance, reading and approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report and town correspondence, Reports from the town officers. Continuing Business, Public comment (upon recognition of chairman), Pay bills, set dates for the November 2025 Levy, Budget, and Town Board meeting.

Chairman Andy Cegielski called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. The minutes from September 9th, 2025, meeting were read. Rick S. made a motion to accept minutes as read. The motion was seconded by Lowell F. The motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. There is \$64768.12 in the bank as of September 30th, 2025.

Andy C. introduced the Clark County Sheriff Kerry Kim. Sheriff Kim spoke of his education and employment with the Clark County Sheriff Department. He was appointed when the former Sheriff Scott Haines resigned. He will be running in the 2026 November Election for the Sheriff's position. He wants to communicate with the towns in Clark County to know what is possibly needed in different areas of Clark County. Kerry spoke of Sex Offender notifications to the Sheriff's Department and their process to notify the towns of any placement of offenders. The board asked if he would like to be invited to the annual picnic to meet the residents and he accepted.

Continuing Business:

- A. **Roads & Culverts:** a.) JJ Brushing will do brush cutting this month and if there is enough money Sandhill Rd. will be added this year. b.) During the maintenance of the grader, it was noted that the power off button should be used in addition the key, as the will save on battery life.
- B. **Speed Reduction:** Andy C. made a motion to accept the Ordinance: Lowering Speed on Town Roads. (Ballard east and Colonial north to Hwy 73). The reduction to 45 mph from 55 mph. Rick S. seconded the motion. The motion passed on a 3/0 count.
- C. **Cemetery Expansion Project:** Harley Surveying bill was 3464.80.
- D. **LP Tank:** the tank has been repaired by Cooper Propane.
- E. **GAF fire bill:** Payment from Appel Logging has been received.

- F. **Assessor Contract: Chimney Rock Appraisals** sent a "maintenance year" contract for \$5100.00. Lowell F. spoke to the assessor for the Town of Washburn, Clarence Becker, about his procedure for checking properties. He only enters property if the resident says that it is ok. This will be put on the November town board agenda.
- G. **Fire/EMS contract:** the Pittsville Fire & EMS departments contract for 2026 were signed.
- H. **Checking Account Signature:** A Resolution: Authorizing the signing of checks by the Clerk, Treasurer and chairman. And pursuant to s.66.0607(3) a signature by either the Supervisor I or Supervisor II can sign if the chairman is unable to sign. Andy C. made a motion to accept the Resolution. Rick S. seconded the motion. The motion passed on a 3/0 count.
- I. **Sex Offender:** After speaking to the Wisconsin Towns Association and the Sheriff, it is not possible to tell a registered sex offender where he or she may live after they have completed their legal obligation. The town board will not be making any Resolutions or Ordinances relating to placement location of sex offender residing in the Town of Sherwood.
- J. **Ordinances & Resolutions:** the clerk is looking into updating the town's ordinances and resolutions. The clerk will speak to Clark County Zoning as to the regulations for junk, and trash on private property. Wisconsin State Statute 175.25.
- K. **Southern Clark County Sportsman:** requested using the town hall once a month during the winter months for their meetings. Rick S. made a motion to allow the use of the hall. Andy C. seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- L. **Next Meeting:** Saturday, November 8th, 2025 starting at 10:00am. The first meeting is the Budget meeting, followed by the Levy meeting and the Town Board meeting.
- M. **Checks approved:** 5298 to 5317 were read.
- N. **Adjournment:** Rick S. made a motion to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded by Andy C. The motion carried.
