The Town Board of the Town of Sherwood, Clark County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under s. 7.32 WI. Stats to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials in a polling place from (7 or 5 in a municipality where voting machines are used) to no less than 3, and the town board has determined that it would be advantageous to the town to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election. There shall be a minimum of 3 election officials on duty at every election. At the discretion of the town clerk, the required number of election officials may be increased for any election. However, the number of election officials shall always be an odd number.


The clerk shall appoint an additional election inspector to serve as a greeter to answer questions, and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for another election official who must leave the room during the voting process.

Section 7.30 (1) WI. Stats: There may be 2 shifts for election workers on the election days at the discretion of the town clerk. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 a.m. and end at 2:00 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 2:00 p.m. and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls.

This ordinance shall be adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80 WI statutes.


Therefore, this resolution is adopted by the town board, Town of Sherwood, Clark County, Wisconsin on the 13th day of Dec, 2011.
