Ordinance: Lowering Speed on Town Roads

The Town Board of the Town of Sherwood, Clark County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town roads in the town as follows:

A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective October 14th, 2025, speed limits on certain Town of Sherwood town roads are reduced or modified as follows:

Ballard Road east of County Hwy Z to Colonial Road; & **Colonial Road** north of Ballard Road to State Hwy 73. Speed Limit reduced to **45** mph from 55 mph.

- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.*
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town roads in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on October 30th, 2025.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
