

2026 TOWN OF SHERWOOD

CLARK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

February 10th, 2026

The meeting of the Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Tuesday, February 10th, 2026 at 06:00 PM at the Sherwood Town Hall, W896 Sherwood Rd, Granton, WI. Board members present: Lowell Freedlund, Rick Schwanebeck, Margaret Schwanebeck, and Samantha Balsiger.

The notice was posted at the Sherwood Town Hall, the Town of Sherwood website, Connie's Roadside Bar & Grill, and at the Sherwood Electrical Substation.

Agenda as follows: call to order, pledge of allegiance, reading and approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report and town correspondence, Reports from the town officers. Continuing Business, Public comment (upon recognition of chairman), Pay bills, set date for the March 2026 Town Board meeting.

Supervisor Rick Schwanebeck called the meeting to order at 06:00 PM. The minutes from January 13th, 2026, meeting were read. Lowell F. made a motion to accept minutes as read. The motion was seconded by Rick S. The motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. There is \$328180.07 in the bank as of January 31st, 2026.

Continuing Business:

- A. **Roads & Culverts:** a) Fire numbers: Rick S. has new numbers and will replace them.
b.) Andy C. wrote the 50/50 Grant and emailed it to the board to review and vote on. A motion by Rick S. to apply for the Clark County Forestry & Parks Dept.-2026 Grant Request for Town Roads. Lowell F. seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- B. **Dog Licensing:** The clerk emailed Connie Zimmerman -Clerk for the Town of Washburn, asking if they have a resolution for Dog Licensing. She spoke to several other clerks, and none had any resolution for Dog Licensing. The dog owners have until April 1st, 2026 to license their dog(s). The treasurer will send a letter to the 2 residents who have not registered their dogs.
- C. **Granton School Referendum:** The representative who was scheduled to speak was no show.
- D. Lowell F. found the Town Hall door wide open. The door is hard to close and may not have latched when shut. Front door handle is broken and Rick S. will repair.
- E. **Next Meeting:** Tuesday, March 10th, 2026, starting at 6:00pm.
- F. **Checks approved:** 5379 to 5398 were read.
- G. **Adjournment:** Rick S. made a motion to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded by Lowell F. The motion carried.

H. **Auditing of the clerk and treasures' books:** follow up. Ledger errors: deposit recorded in clerk's book in January 2025 as \$48338.44 was corrected to \$48388.44 and deposit in April 2025 as \$80.40 was corrected to \$84.15.
