

2026 TOWN OF SHERWOOD

March 10th, 2026

The meeting of the Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Tuesday, March 10th, 2026 at 06:00 PM at the Sherwood Town Hall, W896 Sherwood Rd, Granton, WI. Board members present: Lowell Freedlund, Rick Schwanebeck, Margaret Schwanebeck, and Samantha Balsiger. Speaker Doug Eichten from the Granton Schools and Joy Eichten.

The notice was posted at the Sherwood Town Hall, the Town of Sherwood website, and at the Sherwood Electrical Substation.

Agenda as follows: call to order, pledge of allegiance, reading and approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report and town correspondence, Reports from the town officers. Continuing Business, Public comment (upon recognition of chairman), Pay bills, set date for the April 2026 Town Board meeting. Set the date for the Annual Meeting of the town electors.

Supervisor Rick Schwanebeck called the meeting to order at 06:00 PM. The minutes from February 10th, 2026, meeting were read. Lowell F. made a motion to accept minutes as read. The motion was seconded by Rick S. The motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. There is \$145939.75 in the bank as of February 28th, 2026.

Continuing Business:

- A. **Granton School Referendum:** Doug Eichten, representative for the Granton School District, presented the \$1,250,000.00 School Referendum information to the board. This referendum will appear on the April Election Ballot. For more information: <https://www.grantonreferendum.org>.
- B. **Roads & Culverts:** a) Fire numbers: The new signs are installed; one is already showing damage from birds. b.) The Weight Limit Signs were put up today 3/10/26. c.) the grader has been repaired. There was an issue with the DEF sensor.
- C. **GAFSA inspection:** the Granton FD failed their inspection earlier this year due to not completing building inspections. Rick S. attended their meeting. They are in the process of rewriting the inspection ordinance to follow the State of Wisconsin statutes. They must pass this inspection to receive the 2% Fire Dues from the State of Wisconsin.
- D. **ATC Powerline:** Rick S. attended the Granton Sportsman club meeting where a map of the powerline containing pole placements. The nearest pole to the Rifle Range is west of the range driveway. See attached map.
- E. **Next Meeting:** Tuesday, April 14th, 2026, starting at 6:00pm. The Annual Meeting of the town electors is April 21st, 2026 (postponement meeting) at 6pm.

F. **Checks approved:** 5399 to 5410 were read.

G. **Adjournment:** Rick S. made a motion to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded by Lowell F. The motion carried.
