

**2025 ---ANNUAL MEETING---TOWN OF SHERWOOD

The Annual Meeting of the Electors of the Town of Sherwood, Clark County, WI was called to order on May 10, 2025 at 10:00 am at the Sherwood Town Hall. The Following Electors were present — Chairman- Andy Cegielski, Supervisor- Lowell Freedlund, Supervisor- Rick Schwanebeck, Clerk- Margaret Schwanebeck, Ken Schwanebeck, Linda Schwanebeck and Karen Fluegel.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. After the minutes of the 2024 Annual Meeting were read, a motion by Linda Schwanebeck to accept the minutes as read with the correction of the number of cemetery plots. It was seconded by Karen Fluegel to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried by all 7 electors.

Linda Schwanebeck gave an update on the purchased of the Ambulance. The cost of \$60000 was paid for by donations and fundraisers. The Granton Area First Responders had 177 calls in 2024. 23 calls in Sherwood : 16 were with the Pittsville Ambulance. Linda gave the breakdown of the income and expenses. We would like to thank all the GAFR for their service to our community. Ken Schwanebeck made a motion to donate \$3000 to the Granton Area First Responders. It was seconded by Andy Cegielski. Motion carried by all 7 electors. Linda and Karen asked to be excused due to other engagements.

The Annual Financial Report 2024 was reviewed. A motion was made to accept the report as presented by Lowell Freedlund and seconded by Rick Schwanebeck. Motion carried by all 5 Electors.

Cemetery: A Special meeting of the Town Electors was called on August 1, 2024 to get the approval of the electors for the purchase of the cemetery. The electors present approved the spending of town money to purchase land from 2 residents. The board hired Wolfgram, Gamoke, And Hutchinson S.C. law office to handle the purchase of the land for the expansion of the cemetery. The purchase was completed in April 2025. One parcel of land was \$6880.00 and the second was \$3880.00. The lawyer's fee was \$6651.04.

Rick Schwanebeck made a motion to raise the hand labor wage to \$20.00/hour. It was seconded by Ken Schwanebeck. Motion approved by all 5 electors.

Margaret Schwanebeck made a motion to increase the Clerk's wages to \$8000/year. It was seconded by Rick Schwanebeck. Motion carried by all 5 electors. This increase will take place after the election in 2027. The clerk's position is an elected position. Margaret Schwanebeck said that she will not be up for re-election in 2027.

Margaret Schwanebeck made a motion to donate \$100 to the Clark County Humane Society and it was seconded by Rick Schwanebeck. Motion carried by all 5 electors. Lowell Freedlund told us that Fleet Farm donates the outdated dog food to the Clark County Humane Society.

Andy Cegielski made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and it was seconded by Rick Schwanebeck. Motion carried by all 5 electors.

The 2026 Annual meeting will be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday in April.
