

## 2026 TOWN OF SHERWOOD

### CLARK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

**April 14th, 2026**

The meeting of the Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Tuesday, April 14th, 2026 at 06:00 PM at the Sherwood Town Hall, W896 Sherwood Rd, Granton, WI. Board members present: Lowell Freedlund, Rick Schwanebeck, Margaret Schwanebeck, and Samantha Balsiger

The notice was posted at the Sherwood Town Hall, the Town of Sherwood website, and at the Sherwood Electrical Substation.

Agenda as follows: call to order, pledge of allegiance, reading and approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report and town correspondence, Reports from the town officers. Continuing Business, Public comment (upon recognition of chairman), Pay bills, set date for the May 2026 Town Board meeting. Set the date for the rescheduled Annual Meeting of the town electors.

Supervisor Rick Schwanebeck called the meeting to order at 06:00 PM. The minutes from March 10th, 2026, meeting were read. Lowell F. made a motion to accept minutes as read. The motion was seconded by Rick S. The motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. There is \$107324.98 in the bank as of March 31st, 2026.

#### **Continuing Business:**

- A. **Granton School Referendum and Election:** There was an 81% turnout from the town residents!!! Thank you to the election workers! The Granton School Referendum was defeated. The 2 Pittsville School Board members were re-elected to office.
- B. **Roads & Culverts:** a.) The roads were checked for damage after each rainstorm. b.) The town received complaints about 4-wheelers being driven erratically on town roads. Riders will be turned into the Sheriff's dept. if this continues happening. c.) **Gravel Bids** will be published in the week of April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026.
- C. **Fire bill and Inspections:** a.) The Granton FD have turned in their new by-laws to address issues that they failed their inspection earlier this year. b.) The town's fire extinguishers were recertified. Pittsville FD chief inspected our town buildings as required by law and they passed. c.) The clerk will check with the Clark County Clerk of Courts as to the procedures to collect on the GAFA fire bill for Neil Pfeiffer accident in November 2025.
- D. **Dog Licenses:** 4 notices were sent to dog owners, only one sent in for their dog's license. A second certified letter will be sent and if residents do not comply it will be turn over to the Clark County DA office. Licenses are required under Wisc. State statutes.

- E. **Next Meeting:** Tuesday, May 12th, 2026, starting at 6:00pm. The rescheduled Annual Meeting of the town electors is May 11th, 2026 at 6pm.
- F. **Board of Review:** May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026 from 6pm to 8pm at the Sherwood town hall.
- G. **Checks approved:** 5411 to 5432 were read.
- H. **Adjournment:** Rick S. made a motion to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded by Lowell F. The motion carried.
