

2026 TOWN OF SHERWOOD

CLARK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

June 9th, 2026

The meeting of the Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Tuesday, June 9th, 2026 at 06:00 PM at the Sherwood Town Hall, W896 Sherwood Rd, Granton, WI. Board members present: Andy Cegielski, Lowell Freedlund, Rick Schwanebeck, Margaret Schwanebeck, and Samantha Balsiger.

The notice was posted at the Sherwood Town Hall, the Town of Sherwood website, Connie's Roadhouse Bar & Grill, and at the Sherwood Electrical Substation.

Agenda as follows: call to order, pledge of allegiance, reading and approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report and town correspondence, Reports from the town officers. Continuing Business, Public comment (upon recognition of chairman), Pay bills, set date for the July 2026 Town Board meeting.

Chairman Andy Cegielski called the meeting to order at 06:00 PM. The minutes from May 12th, 2026, meeting were read. Lowell F. made a motion to accept minutes as read. The motion was seconded by Rick S. The motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. There is \$130,116.77 in the bank as of May 31st, 2026.

Continuing Business:

- A. **Roads & Culverts:** a) Basswood 18" culvert: we received a quote for the culvert and installation from Ehlen Excavating for \$2414.66. Dirt Bros. quote for installation was \$1000 with us purchasing the culvert from Hilco for approximately \$480.00. Andy C. made a motion to hire Dirt Bros. and purchase the culvert. Rick S. seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- B. **Cemetery:** The road thru the new addition was discussed. Andy C. will get quotes for the construction from the west highway 73 gate south into the new addition and back out to the east gate. Approximately 502 feet by 12 feet of roadway. Lowell F. will have a new map printed. Andy C. will spray the weeds in the new addition.
- C. **Wages:** the wage per hour for operating personal chainsaw during work hours was raised to \$25.00 per hour from 6AM-6PM; and \$30.00 per hour from 6PM-6AM. Rick S. made the motion to change the chainsaw wage; it was seconded by Andy C. The motion passed. Also, the price for private driveway snowplowing was raised to \$75.00 per hour with one hour minimum. Rick S. made a motion to change the price of private snowplowing; Lowell F. seconded the motion. The motion passed. Snowplowing of roads will be done first, and any other plowing will be done with safety in mind.

- D. **Building Inspector:** Andy C. will contact Dan Hansen about his information.
- E. **Liquor Licenses:** a) Connie's Roadhouse Bar & Grill: Andy C. Made a motion to accept the application for renewal; Rick S. seconded the motion. The motion passed. b) Clark County Sportsman Club: Requested a Temporary Class "B" license for their Bullhead Bash (July 10th to July 12th, 2026) at the Sherwood Park. Lowell F. made a motion to issue the Temporary license; Andy C. seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- F. **Annual Town Picnic:** The picnic is scheduled for August 8th, 2026 starting at noon, at Neal's Pond on Highway 73. The meat and water will be furnished by the town. Please bring a dish to pass. Andy C. made a motion to have the annual picnic; Rick S. seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- G. **Road Signs:** The road signs for Sandhill Ave and Highway 73 were stolen. Sandhill Ave, Highway 73, and ATV/UTV signs will be ordered.
- H. **Checks approved:** 5447 to 5460 were read.
- I. **Next Meeting:** Tuesday, July 14th, 2026, starting at 6:00pm.
- J. **Adjournment:** Andy C. made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Rick S. seconded the motion. The motion carried.
