

2026 TOWN OF SHERWOOD

July 14th, 2026

The meeting of the Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Tuesday, July 14th, 2026 at 06:00 PM at the Sherwood Town Hall, W896 Sherwood Rd, Granton, WI. Board members present: Andy Cegielski, Lowell Freedlund, Rick Schwanebeck, Margaret Schwanebeck, and Samantha Balsiger. Residents: Ken Schwanebeck

The notice was posted at the Sherwood Town Hall, the Town of Sherwood website, Connie's Roadhouse Bar & Grill, and at the Sherwood Electrical Substation.

Agenda as follows: call to order, pledge of allegiance, reading and approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report, town correspondence, and reports from the town officers. Continuing Business, Public comment (upon recognition of chairman), Pay bills, set date for the August 2026 Town Board meeting.

Chairman Andy Cegielski called the meeting to order at 06:00 PM. The minutes from June 9th, 2026, meeting were read. Lowell F. made a motion to accept minutes as read. The motion was seconded by Rick S. The motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. There is \$118077.42 in the bank as of June 30th, 2026.

Continuing Business:

- A. **Roads & Culverts:** a) Andy C. received information from a prison that makes road signs. At the present time we purchase signs from Hilco Supplies. b) Culverts: quote was received from IA Supply LLC for new culvert for Badger Ave. south. Rick S. made a motion to order a culvert for Badger Ave. south. Andy C. seconded the motion. The motion carried. The measurements will be checked before placing an order. c) Graveling of the roads to be done after August 17th, 2026. d) 50/50 Road Grant: the invoice for the work completed was sent to Clark County Forestry Dept. for \$3900.00. e) ATV/UTV signs and posts are here and will be installed.
- B. **Cemetery:** Quotes for the road thru the cemetery are as follows: RLT Outdoor Service-\$17,746.88; Dirt Bros-\$6900; Ehlen Excavating-\$7954.75; and IGGY's Trucking-\$6300. Reps from Dirt Bros and IGGY's Trucking will be asked to meet with Lowell F. to get a clearer explanation of the road project.
- C. **Annual Town Picnic:** The picnic is scheduled for August 8th, 2026 starting at noon, at Neal's Pond on Highway 73. The meat, utensils, plates and water will be furnished by the town. Please bring a dish to pass.
- D. **Mowing:** JJ Brush Cutting only did one pass instead of 2. We will have the ditches mowed again this fall.

- E. **Checks approved:** 5461 to 5486 were read.
- F. **Next Meeting:** Wednesday August 12th, 2026, starting at 6:00pm.
- G. **Adjournment:** Andy C. made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Rick S. seconded the motion. The motion carried.
