

2026 TOWN OF SHERWOOD

August 12th, 2026

The meeting of the Town Board of Sherwood was called to order on Wednesday, August 12th, 2026 at 06:00 PM at the Sherwood Town Hall, W896 Sherwood Rd, Granton, WI. Board members present: Andy Cegielski, Lowell Freedlund, Margaret Schwanebeck, and Samantha Balsiger. Residents: Peggy Winters

The notice was posted at the Sherwood Town Hall, the Town of Sherwood website, Connie's Roadhouse Bar & Grill, and at the Sherwood Electrical Substation.

Agenda as follows: call to order, pledge of allegiance, reading and approval of last month's minutes, treasurer's report, town correspondence, and reports from the town officers. Continuing Business, Public comment (upon recognition of chairman), Pay bills, set date for the September, 2026 Town Board meeting.

Chairman Andy Cegielski called the meeting to order at 06:00 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The minutes from July 14th, 2026, meeting were read. Lowell F. made a motion to accept minutes as read. The motion was seconded by Andy C. The motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. There is \$126063.32 in the bank as of July 31st, 2026.

Continuing Business:

- A. **Roads & Culverts:** a) Andy C. will contact Dirt Bros again to repair the culvert on Badger Ave south. b) Graveling of the town roads will take place after the 18th of August. c) The "burn outs" done on Sherwood Rd and Colonial Ave. was turned over to the Clark County Sheriff. d) Parking of a storage trailer on Campfire Rd by a resident was discussed. The clerk contacted Linda Schwanebeck with the Pittsville Fire Dept. about a trailer left on the road. Jerry Minor from the PFD stated that the trailer was blocking part of the roadway and thought that it was an obstacle that should be on private property.
- B. **Cemetery:** Dirt Bros has more landscaping equipment. Lowell F. made a motion to hire Dirt Bros to make the road through the cemetery. Andy C. seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- C. **Annual Town Picnic:** 35 residents attended the picnic. Discussion about notification of the residents about next year's picnic and other town activities. Andy will compose a letter to include with the 2026 tax bills.

- D. **Checks approved:** 5487 to 5505 were read.
- E. **Next Meeting:** Tuesday, September 8th, 2026, starting at 6:00pm.
- F. **Adjournment:** Andy C. made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Lowell F.. seconded the motion. The motion carried.
